



## Criteria for Scholarships for Florida PRIMA Government Entities

Each year, the Central Florida Prima Chapter is able to assist an applicant whose public entity is not able to accommodate the entire cost of the upcoming Florida conference, by offering an applicant the opportunity to choose the portion of the conference they are not able to pay for so as to assist them in attending the conference and gaining the knowledge needed for themselves and their entity.

We ask that if you wish to apply for the portion of the conference your entity is not able to pay for, give us your name, entity, title, address and phone number. You will see the qualifications of the scholarship as follows:

1. To qualify for a paid Conference Registration for the upcoming South Florida Prima Conference:

**Attend two (1) Chapter meetings since December, 2018 - Value = \$150.00\***

2. To qualify for a two-night stay for the upcoming South Florida Prima Conference on October 13-14, 2019 at the Naples Grande Beach Resort in Naples, Florida:

**Attend (2) Chapter meetings since Dec. 2018 - Value = \$400.00\***

**\*Scholarships will be granted by a lottery draw when the above criteria have been met. The Central Florida Prima Chapter will draw the individuals who meet the criteria no later than July 15, 2019.**
